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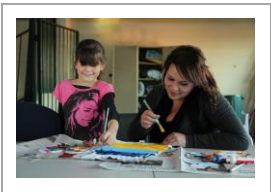

Do you?

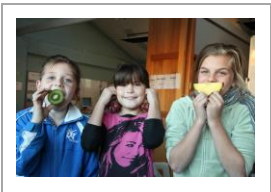


Do you want to talk to your child's teacher but somehow never get around to it?
