Aboriginal Active Recreation and Sports Assistance Program

Guidelines for Applicants

Funds are now available from the TAC to support **Aboriginal** people at all levels of recreation and sport. Funding is available in two categories.

1. A general active recreation and sports category which may include:

- Sporting registration/membership costs;
- Purchase of sporting footwear* and sporting uniforms; and
- Purchase of sporting equipment.

* For sporting footwear generally no more than \$60 will be paid to applicants 6 to 10 years old and no more than \$120 for applicants 11 years and over.

The maximum available to each applicant is \$250 per financial year. You can apply as many times as you like but you will not receive more than \$250 in total.

2. A category for elite sportspeople selected for regional, State, national or international sports events, which may include assistance with:

- Travel and accommodation
- Uniforms

As elite representation can be very costly, each application will be assessed on its merits. Applicants who receive support under the 'Elite Indigenous Travel and Accommodation Assistance Program' may apply for uniform, equipment and incidental costs.

General:

- As funds are very limited, only people who would have difficulty paying their own costs will be assisted.
- Funds are available for Aboriginal people aged 6 or above.
- Applicants who have not previously received funding will be particularly welcomed
- Applications can be received at any time and applicants can expect to know the outcome of their application within one month of the application form being received.
- Payment will be processed at the end of each month.
- Acceptance of a grant implies agreement to publish your name as a grant recipient in the interests of accountability to the Aboriginal community.
- Appeals against decisions may be based only on errors in procedure and not on the decision itself.
