You will have the ability to support our community members' visits to some of our remote places of Aboriginal significance, occasionally for days on end. The facilitators will be required to work together to establish and coordinate 10 key state-wide activities, including undertaking comprehensive community consultation.

Some training will be available, including working with a research consultant to gather evidence to show the true significance of milaythina (country) to positive mental health of participants and the community.
