## National Parks and Wildlife Advisory Council Membership

Expressions of interest are being sought from female members of the Aboriginal community to fill one vacancy on the National Parks and Wildlife Advisory Council for a period of 3 years.

The Council is established under the *National Parks and Reserves Management Act 2002* to provide policy advice to the Minister for Environment and Parks in regards to management of Tasmania's parks and reserves, and to review management plans.

The Council consists of 10 members. Expressions of Interest are being sought for one Aboriginal female position at this time.

Individuals must be formally recognised as Aboriginal as per the Tasmanian Governments policy "Eligibility for Tasmanian Government Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander programs and services".

Applicants should have the following:

- an understanding of issues and topics related to national parks and reserve management.
- a capacity to offer independent advice on Aboriginal topics and opportunities, in relation to national parks and reserves management, taking into consideration community views but not represent any particular organisation.
- good communication and interpersonal skills.

Council members are expected to actively participate in Council meetings, in events and consultations organised by the Council and undertake out-of-session work such as reading and commenting on draft documents.

Council members are paid remuneration and are reimbursed for reasonable travel and accommodation expenses.
