A one day (6.5 hours) interactive presentation for people wanting to find out about the Tasmanian Aboriginal story.

This course looks at the impact of colonisation and discusses the historical account of Tasmanian history during and post invasion and finishes with a look at the contemporary Tasmanian Aboriginal community

The training includes morning and afternoon teas and lunch. Participants receive a Certificate of Attendance.

The two day training course will allow you to achieve the AQF unit of competency called “**CHCDIV002 Promote Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Cultural Safety**”.

This training will assist you to develop cultural safety plans, programs, and processes.

The program is practical and requires you to go back to a ‘workplace’ and complete a project impacting on cultural safety within your workplace. To satisfy us that you are up-to-date on Aboriginal Culture we ask that you know, have completed, or now undertake the short “Introduction to Tasmanian Aboriginal Culture” course before you start CHCDIV002.
