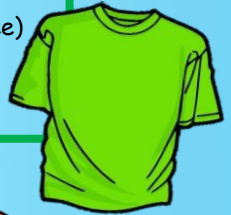
Describing words like colours always go after the thing they describe. eg. pinupuni malaki = cap white = white cap
